ABOUT THE ROMANIAN CHESS FEDERATION

With a tradition beginning in 1925, the Romanian Chess Federation is among the founding members of the International Chess Federation (FIDE).

The Federation is recognized by the National Sports Agency and the Romanian Olympic and Sports Committee as a public utility institution, with the role of coordinating and developing chess activity at the national level.

Based on its results in recent years, materialized by the development of the national project "**Education through Chess**" (the only one accredited by the Ministry of Education), the organization of the "**Grand Prix Romania**" international circuit, as well as World and European Championships, the Federation has become the heart of European chess.

The project Skills and Higher Education through Chess - C.E.S.S. will be implemented in 36 months (June 25, 2025 – June 30, 2028) and has a total value of 22,528,195.00 RON, of which 16,859,673.53 RON is funded by the ERDF (European Regional Development Fund) and 5,668,521.47 RON is the national contribution.



By virtue of official recognition and the current legislative framework, the Romanian Chess Federation is the sole authority empowered to organize, regulate and manage chess activity on Romanian territory.

Through its institutional competence and affiliation with specialized international structures, such as FIDE and the ECU, it ensures compliance with competitive standards and the official representation of Romanian chess globally.
